



Fig. 2: Male life expectancy, 2014





Fig. 4: Male all-cause mortality, 2014










Fig. 8: Male cerebrovascular disease (stroke), 2014










Fig. 12: Male breast cancer, 2014










Fig. 16: Male diabetes, urogenital, blood, and endocrine diseases mortality, 2014










Fig. 20: Male transport injuries mortality, 2014










Fig. 24: Male cirrhosis and other chronic liver diseases mortality, 2014










Fig. 28: Male binge drinking, 2012






Fig. 29: Female smoking, 2012












Fig. 34: Male recommended physical activity, 2011
