
US COUNTY PERFORMANCE



Fig. 3: Female all-cause mortality, 2014





Fig. 4: Male all-cause mortality, 2014




Fig. 6: Male ischemic heart disease, 2014






Fig. 8: Male cerebrovascular disease (stroke), 2014








Fig. 10: Male tracheal, bronchus, and lung cancer, 2014




Fig. 16: Male diabetes, urogenital, blood, and endocrine diseases mortality, 2014





Fig. 14: Male malignant skin melanoma, 2014





Fig. 20: Male transport injuries mortality, 2014






Fig. 21: Female mental and substance use disorders mortality, 2014

Fig. 23: Female cirrhosis and other chronic liver diseases mortality,





Fig. 24: Male cirrhosis and other chronic liver diseases mortality, 2014






Fig. 28: Male binge drinking, 2012






Fig. 26: Male heavy drinking, 2012






Fig. 32: Male obesity, 2011





Fig. 34: Male recommended physical activity, 2011
