
US COUNTY PERFORMANCE








Fig. 4: Male all-cause mortality, 2014





Fig. 8: Male cerebrovascular disease (stroke), 2014
















Fig. 20: Male transport injuries mortality, 2014














Fig. 32: Male obesity, 2011


