
US COUNTY PERFORMANCE



Fig. 3: Female all-cause mortality, 2014





Fig. 4: Male all-cause mortality, 2014





Fig. 6: Male ischemic heart disease, 2014





Fig. 8: Male cerebrovascular disease (stroke), 2014










Fig. 12: Male breast cancer, 2014










Fig. 15: Female diabetes, urogenital, blood, and endocrine diseases mortality, 2014










Fig. 19: Female transport injuries mortality, 2014





Fig. 18: Male self-harm and interpersonal violence mortality, 2014





Fig. 22: Male mental and substance use disorders mortality, 2014

Fig. 23: Female cirrhosis and other chronic liver diseases mortality,





Fig. 24: Male cirrhosis and other chronic liver diseases mortality, 2014







Fig. 27: Female binge drinking, 2012







